

Lincoln Students' Union Accreditation Scheme Process for New Members



1. Register your interest

Use our online contact form on the website and we will get back in touch with you within 5 working days.

2. Application Form

We will send you a digital application pack, which you need to complete and send back with the relevant documents.

3. Property Inspection

We will agree a date with you to inspect your property. Where restrictions are in place, this will be completed virtually. Guidance for Virtual Compliance Checks can be found at www.lincolnstudentlettings.com/landlords. Properties are inspected using the Property Compliance Checklist.

If your current Fire Safety inspection is over 5 years old, we will arrange a fire safety inspection with our independent Fire Safety Assessor. Your contact details will be passed on to them after membership payment has been received and they will contact you to arrange a physical inspection of your property.

4. Accreditation

When the property check is complete and all documents have been acknowledged as complete, you will be sent an Accreditation Certificate and a Digital Accreditation Badge to display on your property listings and your own website. Accreditation is valid for 12 months.

5. Properties Live

Once we have received your property details the listing will go live on www.lincolnstudentlettings.com

6. Feedback & Ongoing Inspections

Our SU Housing Associates will conduct regular arranged inspections and gather feedback from Tenants during the academic year. Students are also able to submit reviews through Linconsu.com
